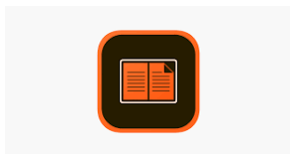



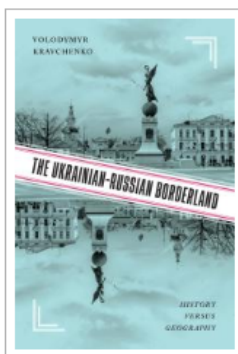

periphery of large urban areas in the Midwest and Northeast. Scattered areas of population gain were evident in recreational regions of the upper Great Lakes, the Ozarks, and northern New England. In contrast, population losses were common in the Great Plains and Corn Belt, in the Mississippi Delta, in parts of the northern Appalachians, and in the industrial and mining belts of New York and Pennsylvania.

The slowdown in rural growth has been precipitous. Nonmetropolitan areas gained less than half as many people in the 2000s as they had in the 1990s. Between 2000 and 2010, rural counties gained 2.2 million residents (4.5 percent), to reach a population of 51 million in April 2010. During the 1990s, the rural population gain was nearly twice as large at 4.1 million.

Between 2000 and 2010, population gains were greater in rural counties adjacent to metropolitan areas, just as they were during the 1990s.
